February is the shortest month of the year and usually the coldest. It is also the time of year we think more on the subject of "Love", since it is after all, the month that contains maybe the most romantic holiday of the year: "Valentines Day."

How and when did Valentines Day begin? There are many legends and stories about who the first "Saint Valentine" was and who gets the credit for having a holiday named after him. What we do know is that February 14th is celebrated in countries all around the world. There were many early Christian saints named "Valentine." Maybe the most popular one was Saint Valentine, who was imprisoned for performing weddings for soldiers who were forbidden to marry. It is also believed that this saint ministered greatly to believers who were persecuted by the Roman government and empire.

The special day was first associated with romantic love in the Middle Ages but began to flourish by the 14th century when people who were in love expressed such affections by giving flowers, candy, and even greeting cards to those they loved. By the time the 19th century came around, businesses realized they had a gold mine on their hands and they learned how to market this special "day of love".

How do you express your love to those close to you? How do you express your love for God? I can tell you that no one holds a candle to the demonstration that God almighty showed toward us. Romans 5:8 best describes His offering:

"But God demonstrated His love for us, while we were yet sinners....Christ died for us!"

Do you know anyone who could demonstrate any greater love than the love that gave a son for a world of sinners? I don't! I wouldn't' give one of my children for a world of righteous people, much less sinners.

Next time you say "I love you" to someone, I want you to think about the love that God has for you. Pause here...let it sink in....feel it....experience it.....think about it....receive it!! Then tell God how much you love Him back.
