Dear Central,

Earlier this year the Lord prompted me to lead our church through 21 days of prayer and fasting for spiritual breakthroughs. As a result of God's grace and mercy the Lord answered our prayers. Over a three-month period, we baptized

more people than we did the previous 12 months. *To God be the Glory!!* Once again I believe the Lord is leading us to do another 21 days of prayer and fasting as school starts and as we gear up for the Fall. There are some very specific things we are asking the Lord to undergird as we seek His glory and His will on the things we believe He is calling us to do.

So I invite you to join us. We are asking at a minimum that in addition to your normal prayer and Bible study times, that you choose **one meal on one day per week** for **three weeks** to join other members here at Central for the purpose of prayer and fasting. We will provide you a guide and prayer list to help lead you during your time. For the first two weeks we are asking our people to a partial fast and the final week for a complete fast for the meal of your choosing. If the Lord calls you to do more, then follow His lead. The dates for this Fall's prayer emphasis will be **August 21st – September 10th.** Remember, the purpose of our prayer and fasting is not to twist God's arm into doing what we want Him to do. It's actually the opposite. It is to put us in communion with Him, so He might show us what He is about to do. This way, He gets all the glory!!

Also in August I will begin a new sermon series called, "We are Central." This short sermon series will examine key passages of scriptures that speak of our special calling as His church and our purpose in our community, state, country and world. It's one thing to find our purpose individually, but when we discover it corporately and together, there is more room for God to be glorified and known.

It is my great honor to be called the Pastor of Central. I love you and look forward to seeing what God is going to do in our midst.

Regional Connect > 1 Sunday School Leadership Training
