RESURRECTION

new sermon series

We all know people who have died. How would you respond if some of them came back to life? A friend? A classmate? A parent? A child? Would that make you believe in miracles? ABC recently began to air a new television series called “Resurrection.” The setting is in a small town in rural Missouri. Their world is turned upside down when several people who have passed away start showing up alive. Can you imagine? What would you do? The people don’t know what to think. Some believe with great faith that a Biblical miracle has taken place. Others aren’t so sure and are more skeptical. Whether you like this type of television or not, it is incredibly intriguing.

At the heart of our faith as followers of Jesus Christ we too believe in miracles. The greatest miracle we believe in is the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Prior to His own resurrection Jesus proclaimed, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me, even if he dies, will live.” (John 11:25)


Faith in Christ promises our own bodily resurrection. Jesus promised this very thing in John 6:4 when he said he would raise those of us who believe in Him on the last day. Paul spoke in great detail about this to the Corinthian believers in 1 Corinthians 15.

During the month of April on Sunday mornings we will examine several “Biblical resurrections” found in the Bible. In both the Old and New Testaments we find nine bodily resurrections of those who were once dead but by the power of God came back to life.

What do these resurrections mean? Why did God choose to record nine of them and what do they mean for us today? What did they mean to the family members and how did it affect the communities where they happened? Do you think that changed their faith? Does it change our faith? Come Sunday mornings or listen on line as we engage what the Bible says about “Resurrection!”
