Recently, I was denied getting on a flight to Chicago that would eventually take me to South Asia. There

was a mix up on the flight manifest. So, the airline rebooked my flight for two days later. My second attempt was canceled due to bad weather conditions. My third attempt got delayed that eventually left me grounded here in Tulsa. It was rather a frustrating experience to say the least.

Have you ever had plans canceled? After the third attempt to leave Tulsa, I began questioning whether God wanted me to go on this trip I had been planning since last fall. Time will tell if the trip ever happens. And time will tell whether God opens another avenue for me to make it to South Asia.

Let's face it. We don't adjust well when doors are closed on us. We want what we want, and we want it right now. Being told "No" does not sit well with our American customs. In the middle of my "flight delays," God brought to my attention a passage in Proverbs 19:21. It reads: *"You can make many plans, but the Lord's purpose will prevail."* 

When I read this, peace came to my heart. Suddenly, I realized that something bigger than myself was directing my path. I still don't know what that is. I still don't know why and when I will be able to make my trip, but I know that it is in God's hands.

Maybe your life is in a holding pattern. Maybe your plans have been canceled and you are trying to figure out what's next. You can be mad about it. But what good would that do? You can be frustrated. But again, what would that do for you? Regardless of your situation, you need to remember that God is good. His plans are perfect. And those plans include you. Sometimes God does shut the door and we have no idea why. Maybe we will figure it out someday or maybe we will never know. But there's one thing we can agree on: God's ways are always the best ways!
