Here is a little about Jeanine:

Jeanine Dooley grew up in Houston and graduated from Houston Baptist University with a degree in ESL/Bilingual Education. After graduation, Jeanine met her husband Steve, and

they moved to Huntsville, Texas where they both taught school, Jeanine in public schools and Steve in the prison system. They had one son, Jordan, and two daughters Candy and Krystal. Jeanine has taught Adult Sunday School and facilitated support group ministries within her church. In 1983-1985, God called Steve and Jeanine's children home to heaven and in 2009, Steve joined them. While life has certainly had its valleys for this family, Jeanine has hung on for dear life to God's promise of Romans 8:28 and has found God to be faithful. In 2012, Jeanine made her first trip to Israel where God begin to place salvation for Jewish people on her heart. As a result, she is a volunteer now with Chosen People Ministries in the state of Texas. Jeanine will be sharing her story in both of our morning worship services on **Mother's day, May 8th at 8:15 and 10:45am.**

#### **APEPT**

If you are new to Central you may or may not have heard the term "APEPT" used. APEPT is the survey tool we use to find out how you are wired missionally to respond to reaching out to a lost world. We believe that Ephesians 4:11-13 describes how, as Christians, God has wired us to either think as Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastoral or as a Teacher. Our definition of each of these are based on a role and not a church-called position. Taking the short 20 question online survey will show you your highest score and the report will provide some initial information on how God can use how He created you, to reach a lost world.

Remember, God is a missional God. His mission is redemption of the world. Go to our website: www.cbcowasso.org and look for the APEPT icon towards the bottom of the page. Take the survey and then a full report emailed will be emailed to Matt Flindt and he will contact you to discuss the results. If you have taken the survey and not seen your results contact Matt Flindt in the church office.

#### Access ACS

Have you ever wondered the best way to get specific information that might be obtained from a church directory? We have an online software called Access ACS and if you are a member of one of our Sunday School classes then you can set up your own account on Access ACS. This allows you access to our entire church directory either by family unit or individual, with or without pictures. The best part of Access ACS is that you have full control on how much information you want to include about your family. It can be just the family names, your address, a phone number and or even an email address including your picture we took when you joined the church!
