

Dear Central,

When was the last time you had your heart examined? For those of you with "Heart Issues" you know more than anyone else how important it is to take care of yourself physically. This includes eating right, exercising regularly, getting plenty of rest, and of course staying in contact with your doctor. Having a faulty heart is not something to take lightly.

When I was 28 years old I was a young married Pastor with three small children. I was also experiencing chest pains. What did I do? I went to the doctor of course. After a series of tests I was told to wait in the "waiting room." Don't you just love those rooms? When I was called back to the Doctor's office he told me to sit down across from his desk. He said, "Hi, I am Doctor Johnson (I forget his real name), would you like a donut? I just got them from the bakery." Here I thought he was going to give me "The Speech," but instead he offered me a donut. Really??? This was not what I expected.

Later I discovered that many Doctors don't have a long "life expectancy" due to the stress of their jobs, poor eating habits, the lack of sound sleep, and the absence of regular exercise. At least this is what I read back in the early 90's. Fast forward about 30 years or so. One could say that I, being a Pastor, as in the "Spiritual heart" business. The only problem is that I, just like you, struggle to keep a healthy heart. My heart gets wounded and sometimes operates less than 100%. How can I help people with wounded hearts when I myself have a wounded heart? It's kind of like me offering a person with heart problems a donut?

The Psalmist said in Psalm 26:2, "Test me, LORD, and try me; examine my heart and mind." David said this in hope that God would recognize that his motives were true and pure and that his life was consistent with his obedience to the Lord and his faith. The scripture I relate to more comes from Jeremiah 17:9. It says, "The heart is more deceitful than anything else, and incurable--who can understand it?"

Someone might argue, "What about the new birth? What about God making us into new creatures?" Oh, I believe the truth of scripture when it speaks about God giving us His Holy Spirit when we are born again. I believe that, at salvation, God indwells us and makes us whole. I believe that we have been given the mind of Christ and that indeed all things are made new. But the reality is we still live in these fallen bodies being corrupted by the flesh. We still sin! Have you ever heard of spiritual warfare and the battle between the flesh and the spirit within each Christian? Paul spoke about this very thing in Romans 7:15 when he said, "For I do not understand what I am doing, because I do not practice what I want to do, but I do what I hate."

There is a constant battle within each believer between the flesh and the Spirit who lives within. And that battle is for the heart. We can either allow our hearts to grow cold and hard or allow the Spirit of God to make them softer and fresh as we age.

From August 31st to September 28th I will be preaching a series entitled, **"Examining the Heart."** We will be looking at what the Bible says about the heart and what God desires to do about bringing healing to that heart. We live in a world of shame and disappointments. God has something better for his people. And it all starts with the heart! As we allow God to bring about healing in our hearts from former wounds, God will begin to use us to help others find that same healing. I greatly look forward to seeing what God will do in our midst!
