Lottie Moon

In Matthew 28:19-20, we have been commanded to "go make disciples of all the nations", this is the focus of the Lottie Moon Christmas offering this year. Currently we support over 5,000 international missionaries by supporting the cooperative program and a portion of our budget is designated to the LMCO. We are on track to give over \$15,150 through our budget but do not want to quit there! The missions committee has set a goal of \$20,000, which combined with our budget would support a missionary over 8 months. 100% of the LMCO goes to the support of missionaries. Prayerfully consider your gift this year. You will also be able to support the LMCO by sending Christmas cards to other members in our church via the Lottie Moon Post Office! It opens this next Sunday! We ask for a donation of .25cents per card.

Building Infrastructure

A very important item that was discussed at the November business meeting, in conjunction with the 2015 budget, was dealing with the expenses of restoring our facility. Currently we have parking lot repairs and sealing, roof leaks and gutter issues that need to be addressed immediately. The Stewardship and Properties committee are working together to prioritize and fund these projects. The initial funding step will include any overage at years end from the 2014 budget (\$1,010,000) and will be deposited in a restricted account to help offset expenses. This overage will be taken after all mission dollars have been paid since our missions budget is based on the percentage of our total receipts. It's very important that you continue to give, so we will have some seed money to begin these projects.

New to Central? Pastor's Discovery Class

If you are new to Central, this special class hosted by Pastor Scott is designed for you! It is open to guests, prospective members and anyone wanting to know more about CBC, what we believe and where we are going as a church. If you have questions, we have answers!
