GRIEF = the conflicting feelings caused by the end of or change in a familiar pattern of behavior. Grief is normal and a natural reaction to a loss of any kind, yet it is also one of the most neglected and misunderstood experiences in human emotions. It is even more of a misaligned event in the local church. Well-meaning Pastors and laymen are not equipped to guide grievers through the "valley of the shadow of death" into God's light of a healthy path of grief recovery. Death, divorce, moving, addictions, issues of control, major illness, retirement, financial changes (good and bad), legal problems, loss of a job, etc. These (and many more) common life experiences can and do cause grief, and left unexposed will over time cripple our emotions. Over a lifetime undealt grief will damage not only ourselves but those around us and affect our spiritual formation.

Central will be offering our first "Grief Recovery Group" as part of our Freedom groups. This six week group will be a confidential safe place for any person who has faced any loss in their life. The group will be facilitated by Rev Kev and Kathy Lackman. Space is limited and childcare is by reservation only, email Angie.Combs@cbcowasso.org, class will start September 9th.

lan Scott will be offering a separate Freedom Group, "Life Hurts, God Heals". The reality of life is we all experience this unwanted intrusion of hurt and pain. Either by chance, others or our own actions. LHGH is a scriptural-based discipleship that takes participants through a journey designed to help them adapt a continuing practice of turning over their pain to the ultimate healer; Jesus Christ. There is currently an ongoing Youth class (8th-12th grade) Sundays from 4-6pm. The Adult LHGH class will be offered Sundays 6-8pm starting September 9th.
