Hey Central Baptist Family! I'm so excited to finally be here as your new Senior Pastor, and my family is getting settled into our new house and neighborhood. We love it here already and feel so welcomed by the community and our new church family. With the current COVID-19 pandemic, my plans to get to know you all and build face-to-face relationships have been dramatically altered. So, I apologize for not being able to see you, but please know that I am praying daily for you and can't wait to see you all very soon.

I also would like to update you on some special plans our staff is putting in place to continue the ministries of CBC during this crisis.

- The best place for the most up-to-date information for CBC is our church website (homepage at www.cbcowasso.org). There you can find current church news, links to sermons, online Sunday school class info, helpful resources for parents at home with their kids, and how you can be involved with ministry efforts during this unique season.
- As you probably have heard, the church building is closed for the safety of our church members and guests. All of our services have been moved to online only and can be accessed at 10:45am every Sunday on our CBC Facebook page, YouTube, and through our church website at www.cbcowasso.org. Many of our Sunday school classes are meeting online as well during our normal Sunday school time. Please contact your Sunday school leadership for updated information on what your class is doing and how you can be involved.
- The church office will be closed until further notice to protect the health of our staff and their families. However, please know that all of your staff are continuing to work from home as they lead our church during this time.

Financially, CBC remains strong. Your staff has taken steps to tighten church expenses and minimize costs. However, resources are still needed for the church to fulfill our ministries to members and the community. My prayer is that all of us will continue to worship the Lord through the act of tithing (even if we can't physically meet each Sunday). Finally, I want to encourage you with this thought. **God is still in control!** He has a plan for this temporary crisis, for our church, and for your family. I know that one day we will look back on all this mess and see how God used it for His glory. It's during times like this that we are called to put all our hope in the Lord.
